HUBBARD'S HILL - RIVER LUD

Visitors to Hubbard's Hills are guaranteed a close encounter with beauty squirrels jump between ancient trees and birds sing to one another as you pass below them in the valley, carved out by glacial overspill 40,000 years ago.But while some might spot wildlife on the calm River Lud as it meanders through the Louth hills, others claim to have seen something more unusual, a ghost.



The ghost of Hubbard's Hills is said to be a wandering soldier, in full uniform, walking with a dog at the top of the hill.

But who is he? And what is he doing in Hubbard's Hills?

The common story, passed from ghost hunter to ghost hunter, is that the apparition is a Scottish soldier who, a decade before the First World War, helped a woman who had lost her dog down a rabbit warren in the Hills.

The pair failed to rescue the dog, though it is said that they got on so well that they stayed in touch, and later fell in love.

Though the pair were married, the man was to outlive his bride - he lived until he was in his 90s, without his treasured wife.

Now it is said that the man walks with a dog atop the hill, wearing his uniform.

The history of Hubbards Hills

Swiss born Auguste Pahud moved to Louth in 1875 to take up duties as a German and French teacher at the grammar school. He married a local girl, Annie, daughter of William and Maria Grant. They were wealthy farmers living at the manor in Withern.

The trustees of Auguste Pahud bought Hubbard's Hills to honour his wish to create a memorial for Annie. They established an Edwardian pleasure garden with a lake, a country park and a memorial which was opened in 1907.

Louth Town Council are now the custodians of the Hubbard's Hill, Trust.

Chocolate Pie

2 (9") line both flan cases with short crust pasty
¼ 2oz margarine
3 eggs
2 ½ cups of white sugar
1 tablespoon vanilla extract
1 ½ teaspoonfuls of flour
1 ½ teaspoon of cornflower
½ cup of cocoa powder
12 fl oz of evaporated milk

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

Place margarine in a small glass bowl and melt in microwave for 45 seconds, or until liquid. Set aside to cool. In a large mixing bowl, beat together eggs, sugar, cooled margarine, and vanilla extract.

In a small bowl, sift together flour, cornflower, and cocoa powder. Stir into egg mixture until smooth. Mix in evaporated milk, stirring until all ingredients are thoroughly combined. Pour half of mixture into each pastry shell.

Bake in preheated oven for 40 to 45 minutes, until set in centre. Allow to cool. Chill at least 4 hours before serving.

In 1802 on board the ship "Investigator" Matthew Flinders circumnavigated Australia. Off the South coast he came across a chain of small islands, around 20 in all, in the waters of Spencer Gulf.

These islands were previously uncharted and therefore unnamed. naming the islands the explorers thoughts turned to home and he took inspiration from the area around Spilsby. The birth place of John Franklin another explorer.

Collectively the islands were given the title of Sir Joseph Banks Group after the famous Botanist and naturalist Joseph Banks from Revesby, a few miles from Spilsby and so the largest island was named Revesby Island. The names of some of the other islands will also sound very familiar; Spilsby, Stickney, Hareby, Dalby, Langton, Kirkby, Partney, Lusby, Winceby and Roxby.

The names of Lincolnshire towns and villages were also used along the coastline of the main land to the west of the islands, Tumby Bay, Point Bolingbroke, Louth Bay and Louth Island, Boston Bay and further south Port Lincoln which is now a large and important town in the region.

The Islands are 12 nautical miles east of Tumby Bay and are now acknowledged as a unique and important conservation park and Marine Sanctuary, providing an unspoilt breeding ground for a large variety of sea birds, seals, fish and dolphins.
